## **LightingEurope explains the Smart Readiness Indicator via a new video**

*Brussels, 22/09/2025* – LightingEurope is excited to unveil a new video explaining the Smart Readiness Indicator (SRI), a tool introduced as a part of the revised Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD).

From June 2027, the SRI will apply to large non-residential buildings with an HVAC capacity of over 290 kW. The objective is to assess how effectively a building utilises information technologies and automated control systems.

Lighting systems play a central role in the SRI assessment. This video explores how features such as occupancy detection, daylight controls, scene setting, and human-centric lighting can help to achieve energy efficiency and comfort goals.

“The video highlights how smart lighting is a key driver of building performance under the SRI. Lighting systems that adapt to people and their environment are essential for creating energy-efficient, responsive and comfortable spaces. Smart lighting ensures that buildings not only meet standards but also deliver better living and working experiences”, stated Elena Scaroni, Secretary General of LightingEurope.
