Our vision: Strategic Roadmap 2025

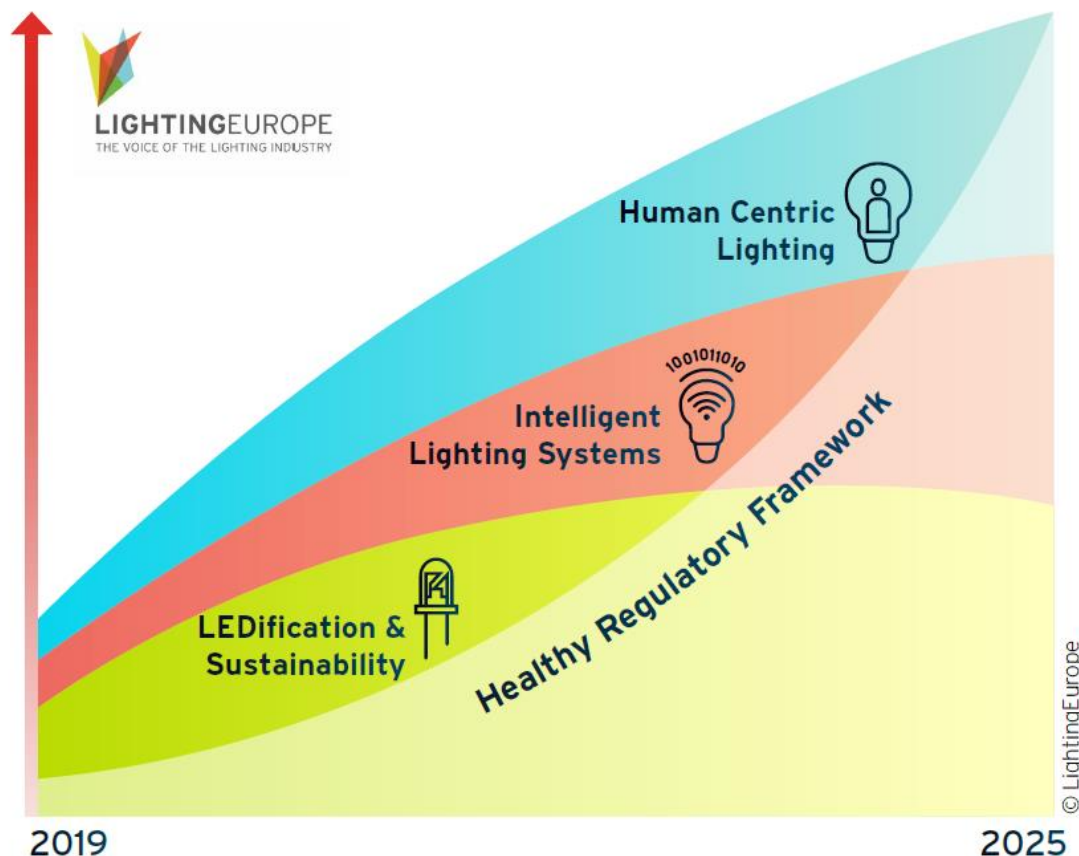
LightingEurope has made progress in achieving the lighting industry's Strategic Roadmap to grow the **Value of Lighting** by 2025.

– benchmarking national lighting markets

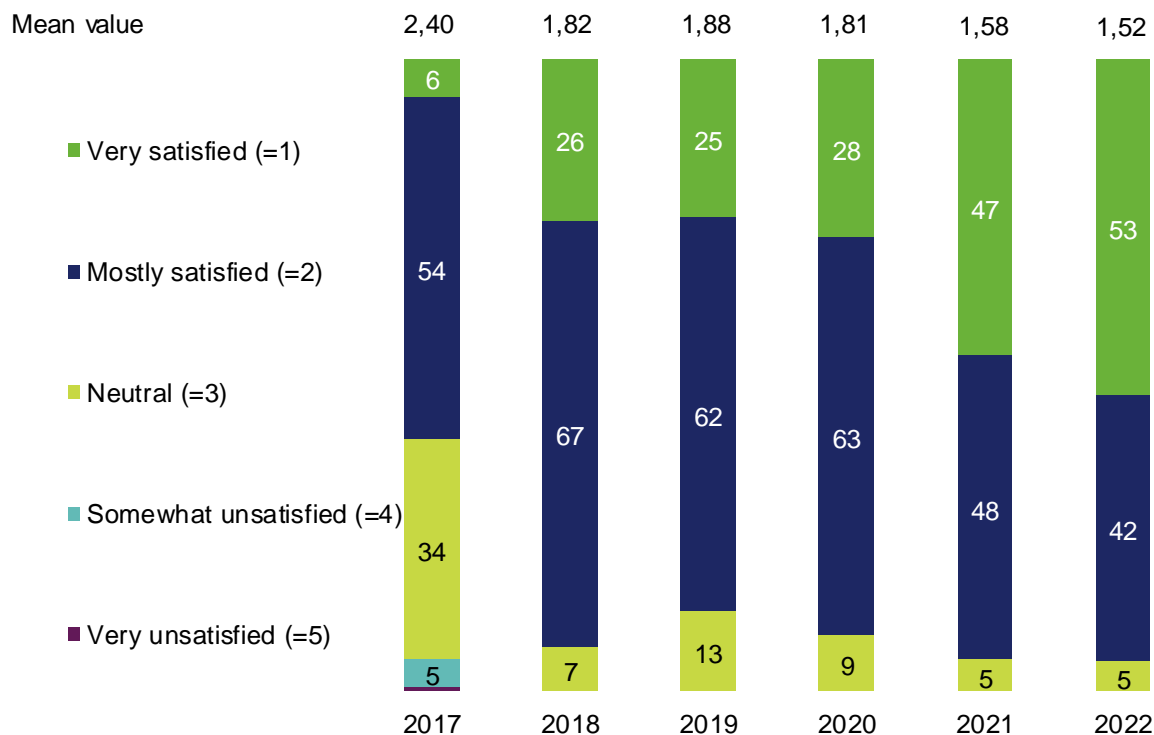
- 2 surveys per year
