Addendum to the LightingEurope Guidelines Version 4 of 30 June 2021

For the application of Commission Regulation (EU) 2019/2020 laying down ecodesign requirements for light sources and separate control gears (Single Lighting Regulation)



Pictograms available under IEC 60598-1:2024 to achieve compliance under Article 4 of the Regulation (EU) 2019/2020.

The following table provides a comparison between:

- The pictograms developed by LightingEurope to ensure compliance with Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2020 and
- The pictograms available through IEC 60598-1:2024, which will also ensure compliance with Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2020, as well as having wider use in countries using or adopting IEC standards.

Manufacturers of containing product can choose freely which pictograms to use and the information provided by this document is not, by any mean, binding or an official interpretation of the requirements set by the Regulation itself. However, when new LightingEurope guides are made for future revisions of Regulation (EU) 2019/2020 it is the intention of LightingEurope to transition to recommending use of the IEC pictograms.
